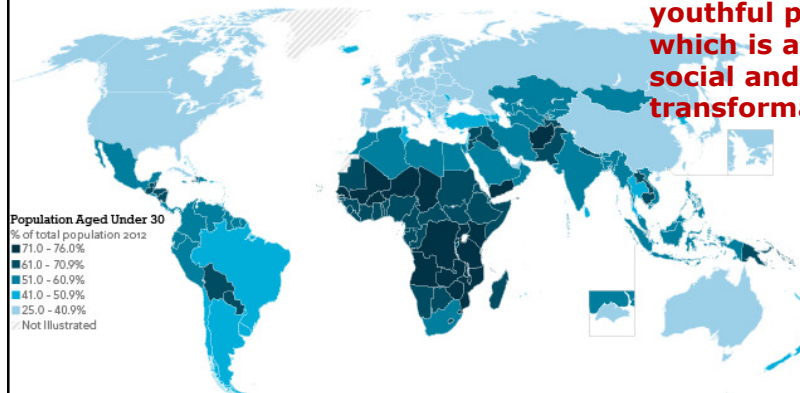

DATAGRAPHIC POPULATION AND HOMES

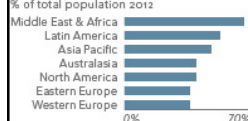
Half the Global Population is Under the Age of 30

Africa has a big youthful population which is an asset for social and economic transformation.



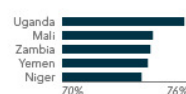
Regional Population Aged Under 30

% of total population 2012



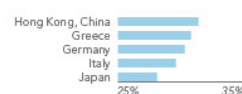
Top 5 Aged Under 30

% of total population 2012



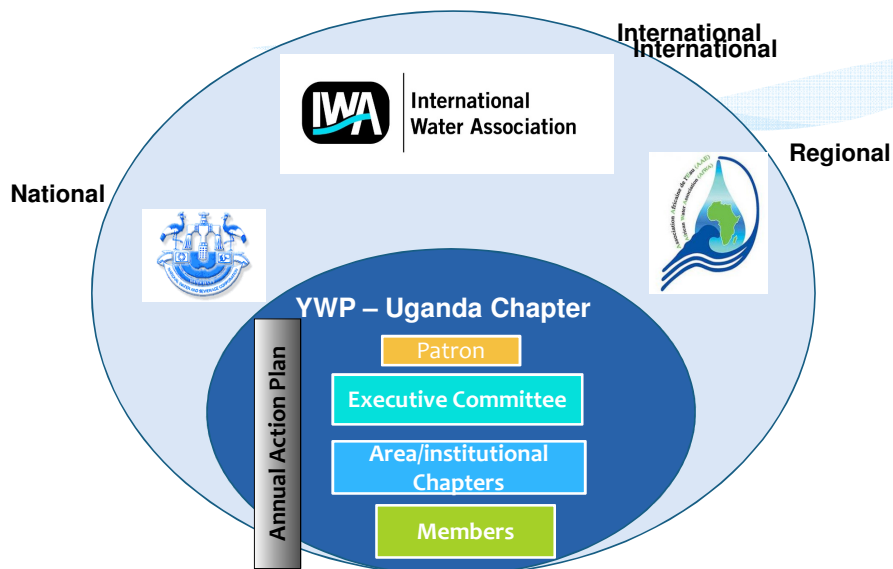
