HALTING THE VICE

As water theft continues to be a major concern, NWSC's has various programs that are pushing for the complete halt of this vice. Among them are the WALOP (Kampala), RESAIL (Entebbe) and SNARP (Jinja). This section aims at exposing those caught in this illegal act and give the various teams a platform to showcase their work.

Faso Hotel in Wandegeya is the latest victim of WALOP. The Hotel was raided at 130pm yesterday afternoon but took the team over 3 hours to unearth the illegal thanks their commitment. Despite the hotel being located opposite LDC, this illegal act will make the management see a different side of the law.

An early morning patrol in Kigumba yielded results. The team found a customer who had cut a water line before the meter. She then inserted a hose pipe which she was using to draw water to construct her new house. The culprit will be fined and her porters will be released from custody when payments have been made.
