WATER THEFT

As water theft continues to be a major concern, NWSC's has various programs that are pushing for the complete halt of this vice. Among them are the WALOP (Kampala), RESAIL (Entebbe) and SNARP (Jinja). This section aims at exposing those caught in this illegal act and give the various teams a platform to showcase their work.

Mbarara team yesterday caused near pandemonium as the illegal reduction team under the billion sprint program intensified its operations. The day ended with shs 3million collected from fines and 1 million paid by an errant pastor identified as Comfort Ronald.

RESAIL was at it again. Yesterday, they unearthed a serious case of illegal water use in Kitala. The victim, a Mr. Senyama David was found with no meter but was accessing supply directly from the main line straight to his house. This water was supplying his bathrooms and kitchen. With an outstanding bill of shs 177,686, the team removed all the supply lines connecting to his house. Culprit is on the run but was advised to report to the office.



Still in the Entebbe Peninsula, in the afternoon of April 22nd, the team apprehended more water thieves. The first was in Kitubulu where a landlord had tenants who were consuming water illegally. They had never applied for a new connection. Lines were uprooted and they were advised to pick up a fine letter.

A one Ariho Doreen in Kitala had her account suppressed last year but she reconnected herself without the consent of our staff. Her outstanding bill is shs226, 868. An effective disconnection was carried out and she was fined heavily.



SNARP fished out 5 illegal water users. One notable one was a lady who was found with a meter bypass that had a tap on it. The illegal was in her garden from where she was fetching water.



In Tororo, the SCAN 100 program was in action in Amagoro B where it yielded 2 meter bypasses. They were all found to be linked to a one Otheino, a former staff member of NWSC who was terminated sometime back. His status has been updated to WANTED.
