The pipe was exposed and constant vibrations from traffic and machinery made it give way. Works went on till 3am but the section gave way again as the affected area is a 90 degree bend. Works resumed this morning and an emergency team from Mbarara has also arrived to assist. Restoring water supply is the only goal and works to anchor the section are ongoing.

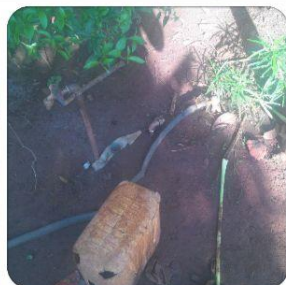
