NWSC holds Kyengera Groundbreaking ceremony

NWSC has officially broken ground for the Namasuba distribution mains at Kyengera. The primary objective of the project is to ensure effective distribution of water from the new Namasuba reservoir to the affected customers in water stressed areas of Namasuba, Ndejje, Lubowa, Kitebi, Zana and surrounding areas. The ceremony was attended by NWSC board chairman, managing director, top management, social media team, LC leaders and opinion leaders including Hon Mike Sebalu.

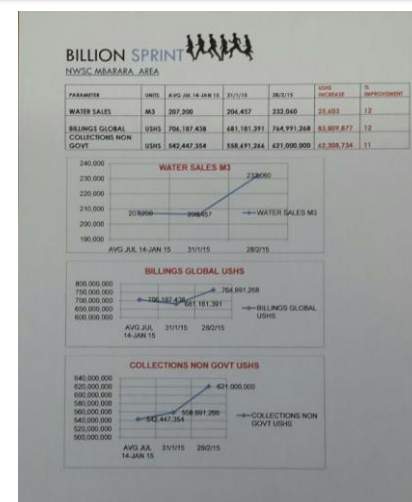
Proposed Site for Seguku Reservoir valued
