

MINISTER EXPRESSES CONFIDENCE IN WORKSHOP OUTCOME

Minister of Public Utilities, Senator the Honourable Emmanuel George, addressed the opening of a three day management workshop titled "Networking on a Utility Transformation Experience" on Wednesday 3rd August 2011 at the Hyatt Regency Port of Spain.

In his remarks the Honourable Minister challenged participants to deliver on the mandate of improved water and wastewater services. He commended the initiative to stage the workshop and expressed confidence in the outcome to move the organisation towards efficiency and high productivity.
